Instruction: JOHA® Vienna chalk

Our Vienna chalk is suitable both for grinding and for wet polishing.

GRINDING

Use a rough linen or a polishing ball for grinding. Dip into the dry Vienna chalk and then process the paint area in circular motions until an even, flat and matt surface is achieved. Then remove the grinding residue using a moist clean cloth.

HIGH GLOSS POLISHING

For high gloss polishing, use a lint-free cloth soaked with water. Dip this into the fine Vienna chalk powder and then polish in circular movements until the desired high gloss has been produced. Should the Vienna chalk powder become clumpy or creamy, use more water, otherwise grinding marks may result. Then remove polishing residue with a moist clean cloth.
